The creed was 500 years in the making.



WHAT DID YOU LEARN CONTINUED

Liturgy means "public work" --it literally first meant "street cleaner".

Liturgy is a public work of the body of Christ - gathered around the body and blood of Jesus Christ.

Congregations are evidence that Jesus has risen.

The right hand = hand of mercy

The right hand = hand of forgiveness

When He is at the right hand He is our high priest and our mediator

The left hand is the "sinister" hand - the hand of judgement.

When Jesus is at the right hand of the Father, the Father looks at us and our sin and only sees Jesus.

Jesus became sin for us.

He offers Himself day and night

WHY IS THIS GOOD NEWS?

The Right Hand is the Gospel. It is proof that Good Friday and Easter worked! His resurrection from the dead and ascension to the Father means that the Father accepted His sacrifice on our behalf. It's the Father's complete stamp of approval. Jesus' work was successful.
